On January 22, 1945 we forwarded your War Savings Bond #C666768981E in the face amount of \$100, registered in the name of Norman B. Moerbe.

In an effort to secure your acknowledgment you advised us that you had not received the bond.

As is our practice in such cases, we filed formal report of the loss with the Postal Authorities. The Postal Authorities have reported its efforts to locate the bond have been unsuccessful and have considered the letter as being lost.

In view of the fact that the registered owner must furnish certain information before a duplicate bond may be issued, it is suggested that you communicate with the Treasury Department, Division of Loans and Currency, Merchandise Mart, Chicago 54, Illinois, to secure the Application for Relief on Account of Lost Bond and other necessary forms.


